Minutes:

1. Welcome and call to order: 6:28pm

2. Review of previous minutes: accepted unanimously.

3. Report from HI

a. Outside inspectors, free of cost as part of the public health excellence consortium of which Hadley is a member, should be available within next few weeks for assistance. Ben will coordinate.

4. Report from Town RN

a. Marcy will lead info session on mental health and next month on women and heart disease at the Senior Center with first session scheduled for 1/10/24

5. Budget proposal review

- a. Dragon to f/u with Ben re: Increasing Committee Health/Program line item
- b. Budget narrative: Given that the BoH was without a town RN for a period of time the money budgeted for FY23 has not been used in its entirety. It will be applied to providing more educational and wellness forums/sessions until the end of FY24. BoH will need to vote on extending town RN hours to 10/wk for FY25 at its next meeting and submit this proposal in its budget.
- c. Animal inspector: increase stipend from \$1k to \$2k; Dragon presented document supporting increase hours; if the BoH had to find someone to fill the role other than Dragon, then a \$2k line amt is insufficient; Range of 156-228 hrs/year @ \$15/hr (minimum wage) would be at least \$3k for 200hrs/year; currently inspector is in freq communication w/animal control officer plus has over 70 farms to inspect. This has not been part of our shared expenses with other towns; option is to ask for \$4k (@\$20/hr) vs \$3k and do incremental approach; this should also be reflected in the budget narrative. Motion made to increase to \$3k accepted by Mosler, Mastrangelo; Dragon abstaining
- 6. Report from admin assistant Peter

- a. Permitting: approx 2/3 of food establishments have submitted fees on line
- b. Another Covid test report came in on the waste water which will shared with BoH; students have not yet come back so anticipating a spike
- 7. Any other business that could not be reasonably anticipated: None
