- a. discussion regulations re: private wells. Please read the following <u>MassDEP regulations</u> for private well before meeting; this will be lengthy process but given that there are many agricultural businesses, goal is to make sure that there are no surprises for these businesses.
- b. body art regulations: application is on-line. It is not posted in our by-laws. Ben is not allowed to enforce anything as/Hadley's legal team. Legal team will codify this; BoH will review hopefully before the one body art establishment is up for renewal.
  - c. establishment that had the high bacterial count has been totally resolved
  - d. summer camps finished with inspections; went well
- e. annual food license SOP Ben distributed his draft; requested that we review and give feedback at the next meeting
- f. public engagement: Ben is mtg w/Hadley Business Council 8/8 to review inspection procedures
- g. food inspections: refrigeration in variety of places have been difficult to control b/c of excessive heat
- h. Amherst sewage release complaint from resident that he had not seen this posting on our website; request that the reverse 911 (blast messaging) be used: Jennifer & Ben will meet to ensure that this happens
- i. Septic system inspections: Ben will continue to go out with Kevin until he decides otherwise;
- j. confidentiality regarding naming food establishments; discussion about perception/reputation of establishments Dragon and Ben will work on shared file system
- 4. Update from town RN Marcy Moyel Fleming; discussion re: supplies
- a. Town RN role should focus on Wellness. Marcy requests a thermometer; donation of BP cuff and stethoscope is pending
