**Request for Determination - 87 Hockanum Rd**

Proposed single family home presented by Bob Stover who delineated the wetlands on the property. Commissioner Mieczkowski recused himself as he performed perc tests for the sewer associated with the proposed project.

Concern was expressed regarding location and paving of the driveway, and Stover was able to confirm no paving is planned and understands future paving will require a new application.

Commissioner Matuszko made a motion to issue a negative determination #3, to Kristin and Ayres Stiles-Hall, the project applicants. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Szymkowicz and there were 4 votes in favor.

Proposed single family home presented by Adrienne Dunk of GZA who delineated the wetlands on the property.
