

## Hadley Historical Commission Meeting

June 26, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm by Ginger Goldsbury.

Mr. Neyhart brought in a catalogue from outdoor builders, ICON, to show examples of gazebos for the Town Common. The priority is low maintenance. Considering the goal is to host concerts and gatherings, we were looking at 30 foot diameter gazebos for approximately \$70,000.

Mrs. Keegan is putting the project on the town meeting warrant.

Denise is will write up an official message to the Planning Board that the Hadley Historical Commission is okay with metal roofing on new buildings.

The Commission received contact from the Cultural Resources Unit at MassDOT who are currently working on putting together a pilot project to conserve the Mass Bay Colony Tercentenary markers in MassDOT's District Two. It has been suggested that the Tercentenary Marker #226 on Rt. 9 in Hadley be moved for better visibility. The Commission agreed and will reconnect with the Cultural Resources Unit, suggesting to have it moved to be near the "Welcome to Hadley" sign and bike path for better visibility.
