<u>Nexamp</u> seeks to modify solar array for energy storage by installing concrete pads for battery storage in buffer zone off *Westgate Center Dr*. (Map 10D Parcel 29). Site visit conducted on December 1st by Gary and Shyla who met with Mickey Marcus of SWCA and Jim Hadley of Nexamp.

Other Business

a) <u>Sign</u> for Dawson Reserve *off Rocky Hill Rd*. Shyla has located the design and will need to find a way for it to get printed. Unlikely we can install it until spring given ground freezing. Commission thoughts? Edwin has volunteered to post.

b) L. Desforges to be cutting down 6 or 7 trees between now and the Spring at 3 Mitch's Way; a site visit was conducted on 10/2021 by Edwin Matuszko and Shyla Davis, trees confirmed to be hazardous, permission granted; work will be done by the Desforges themselves. Commission being asked to physically sign the Emergcert for this work. One tree has come down; photos sent to Conservation email 11/29, stump remaining as requested.

c) Joe and Michelle Boisvert at 6 French **St** to be presenting a bank stabilization plan. Upon receipt of this plan, the commission can review and request changes as needed. A site visit to the property was conducted by Edwin Matuzko, Gary Pelissier, and Shyla Davis on November 17th to observe the conditions. The bank has eroded drastically due to a high flow of water during storm surges and the property owners have lost their erosion control barriers due to the flow. They have been asked to come up with a way to stabilize the bank and implement erosion control and the town has installed new pipes across the street to enhance flow capacity.

d) Signatures needed for the issuance of a form 8b, COC, to Western Mass Food Bank regarding the installation of a well. Site visit 12/7 by Edwin and Shyla to ensure all conditions satisfied.
