a) Update on Knightly Rd headwall replacement proposal; the ConCom is going to require a new Notice of Intent to be filed due to the scope of changes in the revised plans. Conservation staff and the chair have been in contact with DPW, and the engineer handling the project, Nick Cristofori of Comprehensive Environmental Inc, will be presenting informally to field questions and share current plans.

b) Sign for Dawson Reserve off Rocky Hill Rd. Decide on product based on quote from Amherst Copy and Design Works. Edwin and Shyla visited the site on January 26th to evaluate need for size and positioning. Remaining action is to agree on a size, monetary allowance, and which account to charge for this purchase, as well as purchasing procedure (i.e., authorization, when and by whom).
