**Green Communities & Energy Review-** Review of the latest Hadley Energy Reduction Plan *Overview of Goals for Years 1-3* 

Initially, Hadley will use the Green Communities Designation grant funding to make energy improvements in buildings. The savings generated from the initial projects can then be paired with additional Green Communities grants to continue with energy efficiency projects. The town has identified projects at Hopkins Academy, Hadley Elementary School, and the Town Barn, as being the top priorities. These buildings are among the least efficient, and there are a number of projects at these buildings that have substantial energy and cost savings, and a short payback period.

Planned improvements in each building include:

  - Building Envelope Retrofits
  - Kitchen Hood Controls
  - Steam Trap Survey
- Hadley Elementary School
