FY 2020 Hadley Community Development Fund Application

The Hadley Select Board will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, February 5, 2020 at 7:00 PM** at the Hadley Town Hall, 100 Middle Street, Hadley, MA. In the event of a weather cancelation, the meeting will occur at the next scheduled Select Board meeting on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at the same time and location. The purpose of the hearing will be to discuss the town's proposed FY20 Community Development Block Program application. The application will be filed no later than March 6, 2020. The Pioneer Valley Planning Commission (PVPC) is assisting the city with this application.

Residents are encouraged to attend this meeting to discuss the FY20 application to the MA Department of Housing and Community Development for approximately \$550,000 in available Community Development Block Grant Funds. All persons with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. Those unable to attend can send written comments to the Town Administrator, 100 Middle Street, Hadley, MA 01035.

Projects currently being discussed include housing rehabilitation services to qualified Hadley households, a planning study to evaluate re-use opportunities for the former Russell School, and planning study that will evaluate Hadley properties for accessibility compliance; an ADA Transition Plan.

The Hadley Town Hall and Select Board meeting room are handicapped accessible.
