Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections.

Last day to register to vote and change party
enrollment for the State Primary:

Saturday, August 22, 2020

Last day to apply for an Absentee or Early Vote
Ballot **BY MAIL** before the State Primary:

Wednesday, August 26, 2020 – 5 PM

Last Day to apply **IN PERSON** for an Absentee Ballot
before the State Primary:

Monday, August 31, 2020 – 12 PM

In-Person Early Voting

In Person Early Voting prior to State Primary:
Saturday, Aug. 22, 2020 – Friday, Aug. 28, 2020

Hours:

Saturday, August 22 2PM – 6PM Sunday, August 23 from 10 AM to 2 PM

Monday, August 24 – Friday, August 28 – 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Vote at your Polling Location on Election Day – Tuesday, September 1, 2020

Hours from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.
